SAVAGE CREEK GOLF COURSE AND SENIORS CLUB HISTORY

Tucked away in the beautiful landscape of Savage Creek Golf Course is a story of vision, dedication, and community. Named after a local farmer and the nearby road, Savage Creek has grown from a dream into one of Richmond's most unique golfing destinations.

The journey began in 1995 when Harry and Susan Hogler opened Country Meadows Golf Club. It wasn't long before Bill Sides, who managed the pro shop, encouraged a group of regular golfers to form a Senior Men's Club — creating a strong sense of camaraderie that continues to this day.

Inspired by the success of Country Meadows, Harry Hogler set out to create something even more ambitious. In 2005, he purchased the land that would eventually become Savage Creek Golf Course. At the time, the property was flat, low-lying, and boggy — hardly what most people would imagine as the future home of a premier golf course. But Harry saw potential where others saw obstacles.

Personally designing the course himself, Harry transformed the landscape to break away from the traditional "flat" reputation of Richmond golf. Massive amounts of soil were brought in to shape rolling fairways, dramatic contours, and elevated greens that now define the course. What began as a 13-hole layout has expanded into today's exciting 16-hole course, with a 17th hole already under construction.

In September 2018, the dream officially became reality when Savage Creek Golf Course opened its doors. Soon after, the Savage Creek Senior Men's Club was established, continuing the tradition of friendship, sportsmanship, and community that started years earlier at Country Meadows.

Today, the club proudly boasts approximately 160 members, including many original golfers who still participate every week. Numerous members belong to both the Savage Creek and Country Meadows Senior Men's Clubs, strengthening the bond between the two golfing communities.

Thanks to the Hogler family's passion and commitment, members of both clubs enjoy more than just golf — they enjoy breathtaking park-like setting.

KP Definitions and Procedure

KP Hole 1st or 2nd shot

Played on a par 3 hole. First shot AND some 1st or 2nd shots That land on the green. Procedure:

If your ball is closest to the pin take the identifying stake and place it by your ball. Print your name and member # on the card

KP Hole Second Shot:

First shot from tee lands on the fairway and your second shot lands on the green. Place stake at your ball . Print your name and member Number on the card.

KP Hole Any Shot Off the Green: You can hit your ball any number of times until the ball lands on the green. Closest to the hole place the stake at your ball. Print your name and Member number on the card.
